4807m is the altitude of the highest European peak, Mont Blanc, located in the French Alps

French Alps is also the first global region for outdoor and winter sports.

The French Alps owns more than 100 passes for amateurs, including the famous « Col de l'Iseran », culminating at 2770m & « Col du Galibier » with an altitude of more than 2600m, and, of course, the iconic « Montée de l'Alpe d'Huez », an ascent with 21 turns.

The French Alps already welcomed more than 300 « Tour de France » stages, and organize every year « L'étape du Tour » gathering more than 10 000 cyclists.

There are 85 volcanoes in Auvergne

Some are protected by the Unesco World Heritage and can be found in a regional nature park, nearby the city of Clermont-Ferrand.

Auvergne owns numerous cycling itineraries, including the famous GTMC (Grande traversée du massif central), where moutain bikers can enjoy unique views during more than 400 km.


Notice that the GTMC has special path for gravel bikes.



Vallée de la Gastronomie starts in Dijon, ends in Marseille, crossing Burgundy, Beaujolais, the city of Lyon - the world capital of gastronomy - Rhône Valley and Provence.



More than a 1000 touristic structures are labellised under Accueil Vélo. What's Accueil Vélo? A label rewarding hotels, campsites or tourist offices for the quality of their services offered to cyclists.



The cycling industry is key in our region, with more than 50 bike manufacturers but also almost 500 bike rentals. More of a thousand of biking guides are working in AURA, making it the first in France.

Chambéry is a city of art and history, counting numerous paved alleys, ancient colorful façades, must-see monuments as the Château des Ducs de Savoie (hiding the greatest chiming clock of Europe, with 70 bells), as a testimony of more than a 1000 years of history, linking Savoie and Italy.

The destination Savoie stands under the label « Accueil Vélo » with more than 500km cycling routes (véloroutes, green lane, passes and uphills).

The vineyard of Savoie owns 23 grape varieties, the highest number in France on a defined territory, and 7 of them are unique in the world. (jacquère..)

Grand Chambéry is crossed by Véloroutes pathways between the alpine lakes (Bourget, Annecy and Léman lake), the great passes of the Alps, and picturesque vineyards. The location is perfect for a stage, and convenient for family trips.





















STRENGTH IN NUMBERS:

In order to better understand the current status of the EuroVelo network and to help determine which factors contribute increasing the number of users, ECF has been establishing some key statistics on the European level.

Specifically - the current level of development across the 90,000 km that make up the network; usage based on the results of a network of counters installed across the continent by the company Eco Counter; and the web statistics of FuroVelo.com.








Our mission is to promote the further development of a sustainable, strong and well-connected European cycle route network, which

- Fosters sustainable tourism.













 Around 41.6 million Germans went on at least one cycling day trip in 2021 (+11 million)!



An average Dutch cycling holiday lasted 3.8
 nights, which means that approximately 6.8
 million overnight stays took place during 2021.



 The economic spin-offs of bicycle tourism in France have increased by 46% in 10 years to reach €5.1 billion per year



• The daily stages, for 70% of Italian respondents, are between 50 and 70 kilometres.


