Departure by bike. Martigny-Aigle route

Depart Martigny for the banks of the Rhône and the SuisseMobile no. 1 cycle route to the World Cycling Centre (WCC) in Aigle. The WCC houses the headquarters of the International Cycling Union (UCI) and a top-level training centre with a covered velodrome and BMX track. The centre is open to groups of amateur cyclists for an exclusive experience.

Lunch at WCC

Cycle up to Villars via Gryon

The ascent to Villars (where the Tour de Suisse for men and women will be held in June 2024) via Gryon: a quiet ascent with splendid views of the Rhone Valley and the surrounding peaks, which rise to over 3,000 metres.

Check-In at your hotel (TBC)

Aperitif and meal with presentation of the Alpes Vaudoises cycling destination (road + gravel)

Departure by bike. Itinerary Villars-Leysin via Col de la Croix, Les Voëttes and La Comballaz

Col de la Croix and the little secret roads The day begins with the Col de la Croix (1778 metres), a favourite climb for local cyclists, which also saw the Tour de France pass through in 2022. At the summit, you can admire the Col du Pillon and the imposing Massif des Diablerets in the distance. Then it's on to Leysin, the town that will host the queen stage of the Tour de Romandie in 2024. To get there, we'll be taking mountain roads away from the traffic: a privilege that the Vaud Alps offer to road cyclists with a passion for the mountains.
