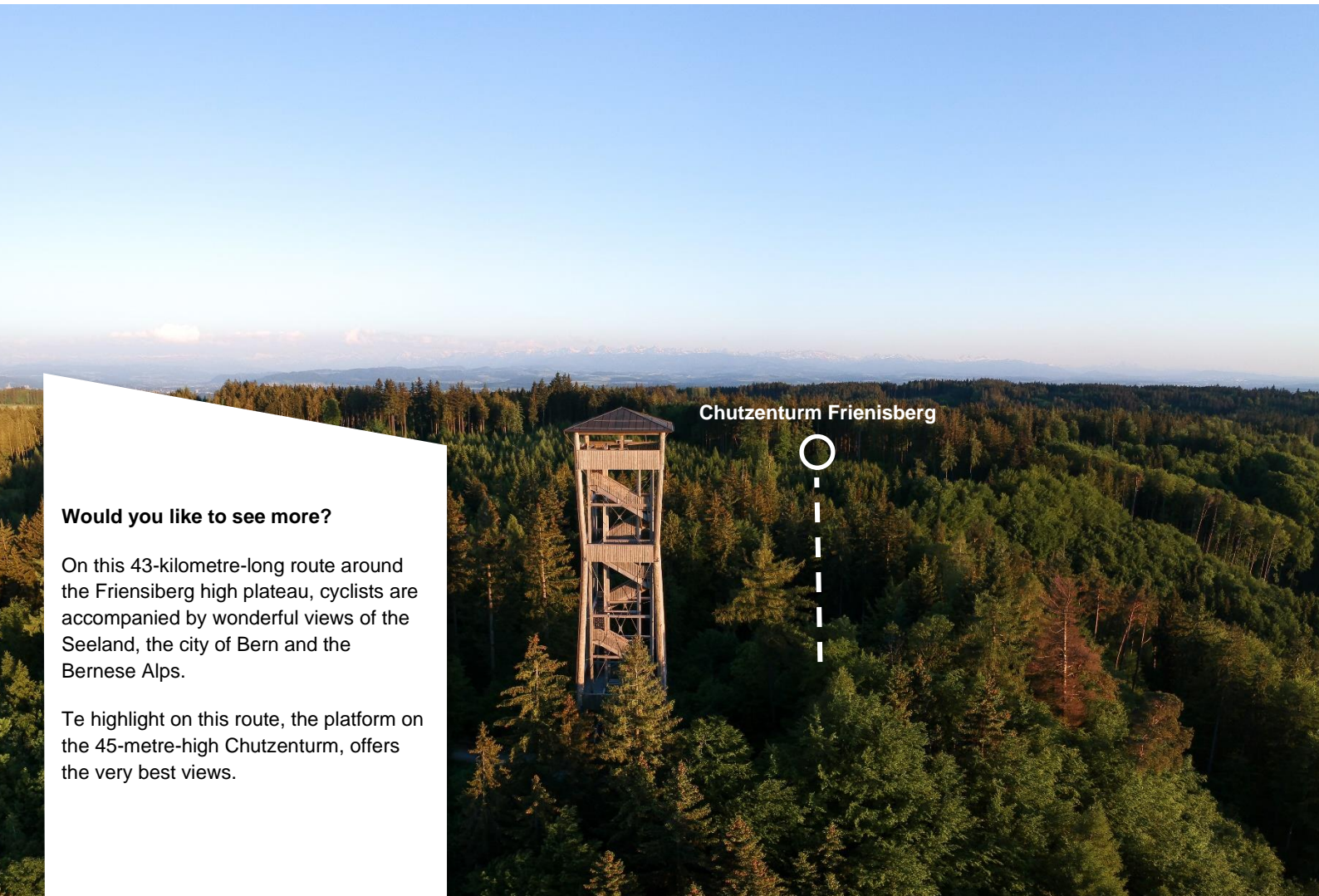
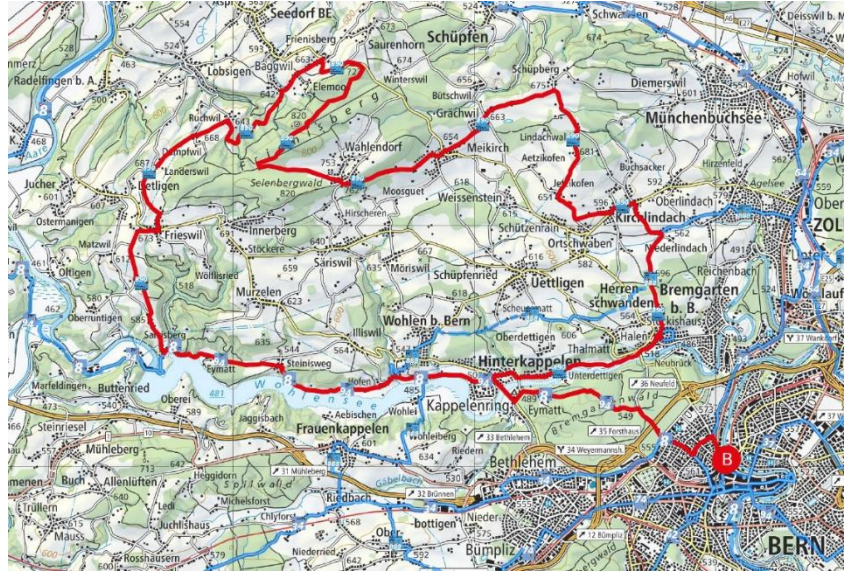
Heading back to Bern
