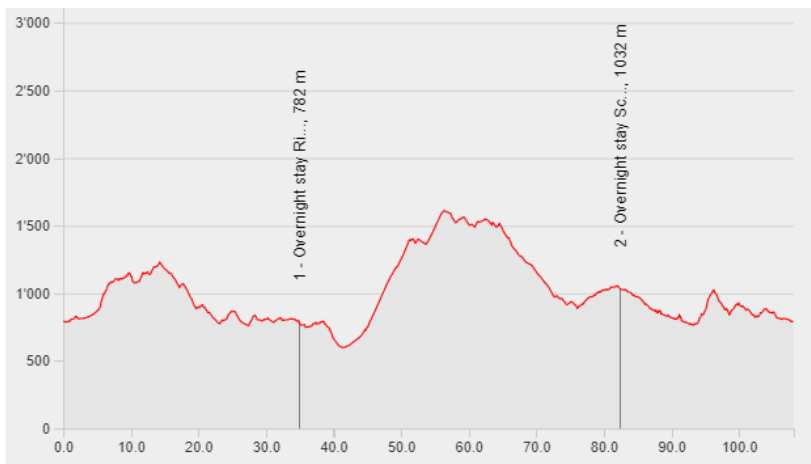
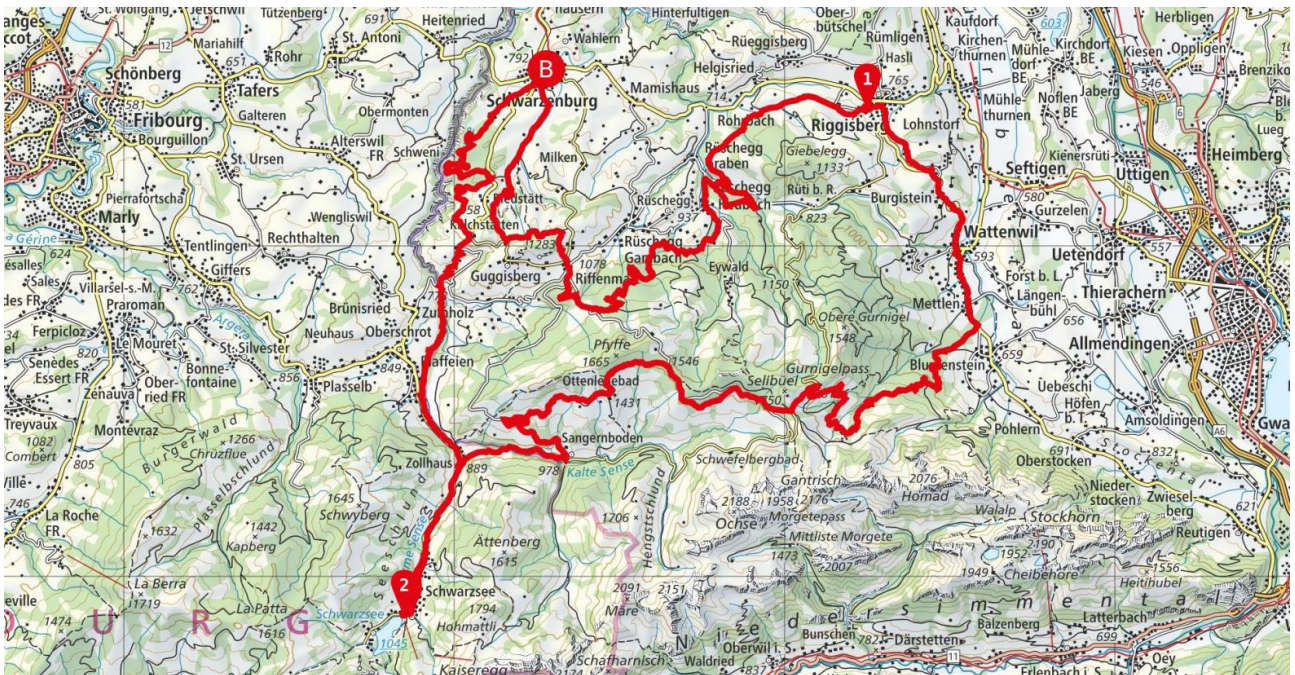

Off to the Nature Park Gantrisch!

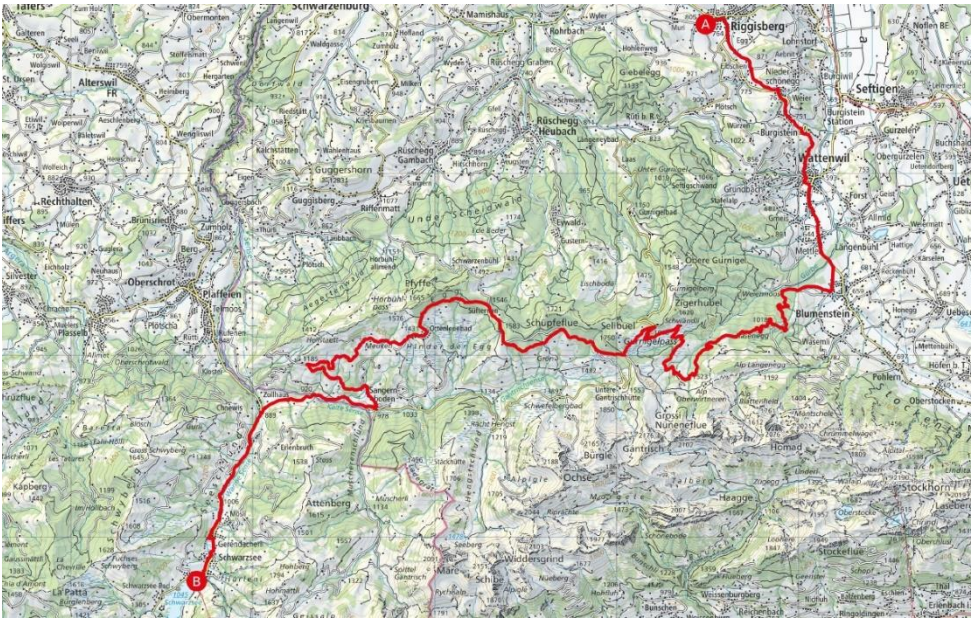
- Right after the Cycle Summit, we're heading to Nature Park Gantrisch.

And with over 300 kilometres of gravel bike tours, the region is a true gravel bike paradise.

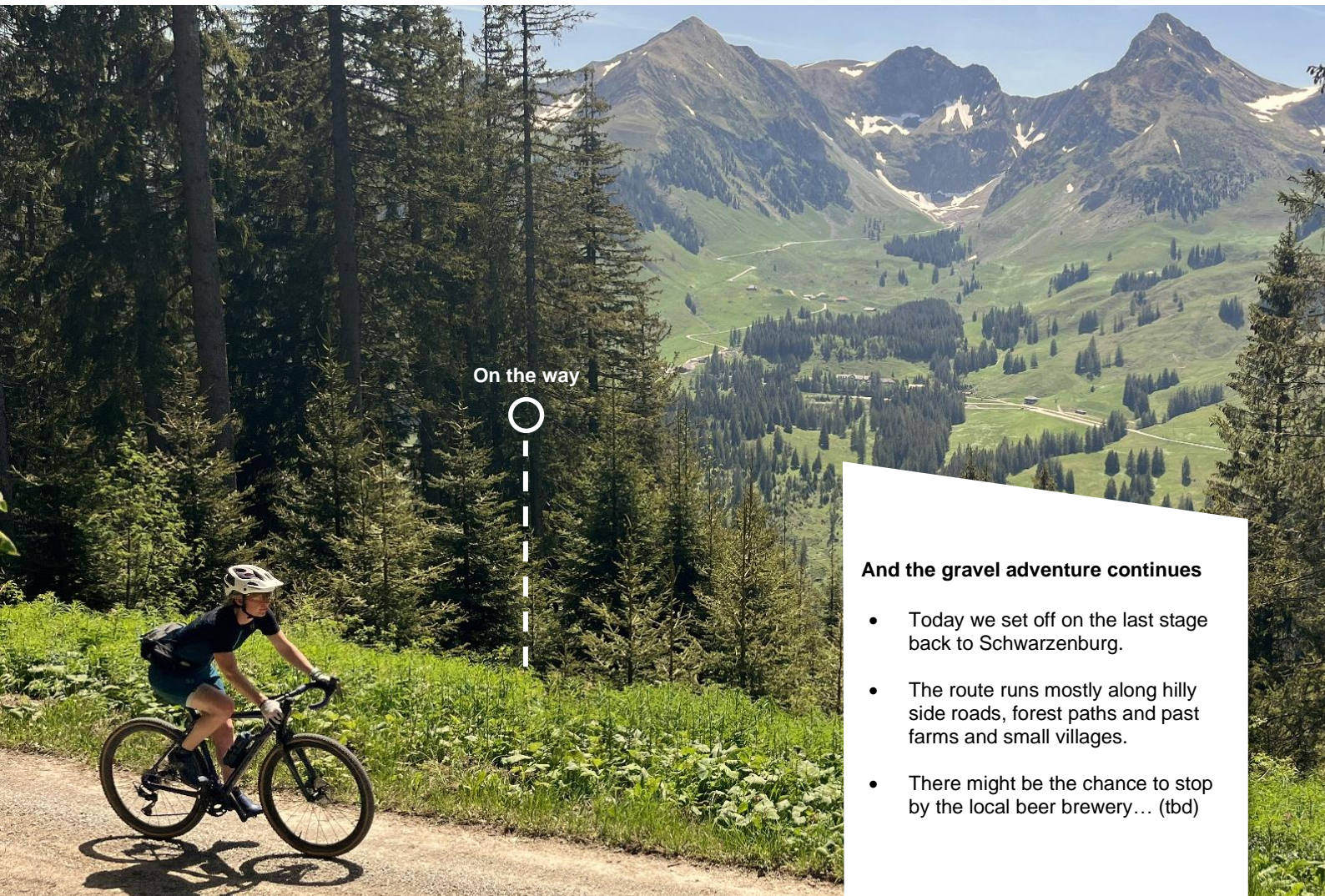
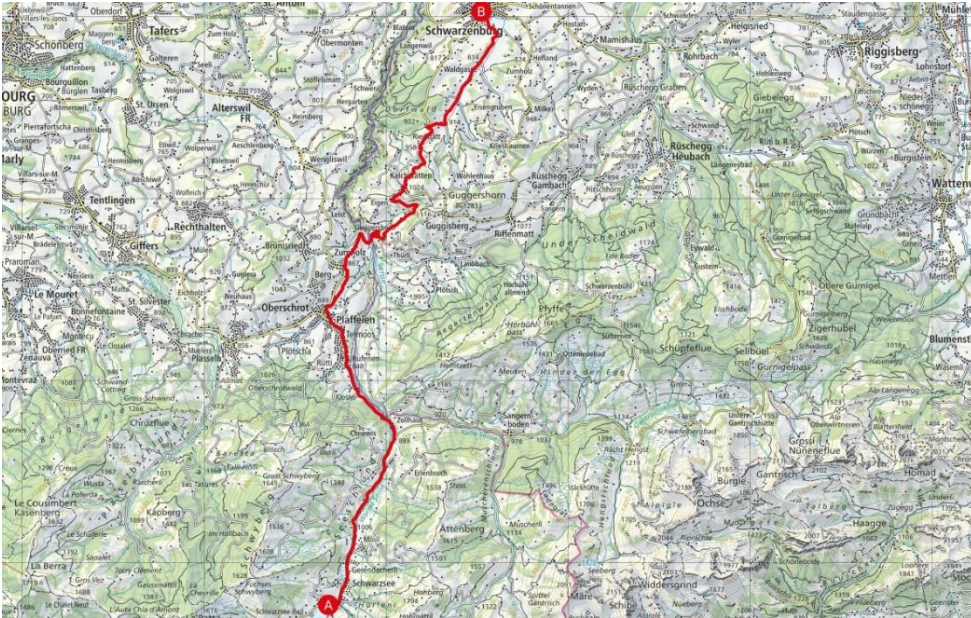
