Road cycling tour to Bern

Friday, 11.10.2024: Yverdon-Les-Bains

Road cycle tour Geneva – Col de Marchairuz – Lac de Joux – Yverdon-les-Bains: approx. 115 km \uparrow 1'760 m \downarrow 1'710 m (more details)



Geneva is Switzerland second largest city, but you will leave the bustling centre behind you only in a couple of minutes. From here, you cycle towards Jura. A challenging climb with marvellous views on Lake Geneva takes you up to Col de Marchairuz. After a steep descend you will reach Lac de Joux, a beautiful lake, nestled between the crests of Jura.

Enjoy the scenic ride on the shore of the lake before cycling towards Lac de Neuchâtel. On its southernmost end you will reach the small town of Yverdon-les-Bains – widely known for its thermal baths. The perfect place to relax after today's challenging ride.

Saturday, 12.10.2024: Bern

Yverdon-les-Bains – Neuchâtel – Lake Biel - Bern: approx. 100 km ↑ 945 m ↓ 840 m (more details)

Lac de Neuchâtel is one of Switzerland's largest lakes, situated just on the foot of Juras crests. On a clear autumn day, you have a marvellous view of the snow-covered peaks of the Bernese Oberland. The panorama together with vineyards and charming towns make the ride on the shore of the lake a special treat to start your day.

After a short stop in the small town Neuchâtel, you will cycle along the "Zihlkanal" to reach Lake Bielersee. From here you will cycle towards Bern and reach the river Aare. Quiet roads take you to the city centre of Switzerland's capital.
